

ORDINANCE NO. 1061

An Ordinance amending the Slidell Subdivision Regulations by making a Tex change to Section 2.219 and add Section 5.301.12.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, LOUISIANA, IN LEGAL SESSION CONVENED, that the following changes be made to the Slidell Subdivision Regulations.

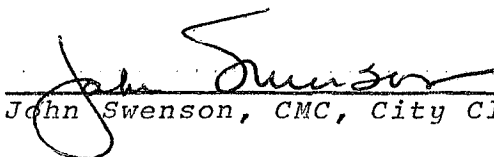
Tex change - Section 2.219

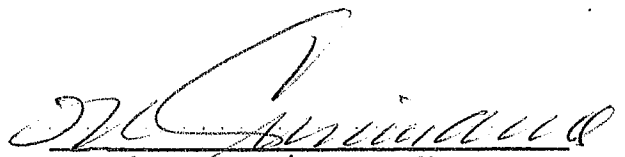
Lot of Record: A parcel of land, the dimensions of which are shown on a map on file with the Clerk of Court. All lots of record shall front on and have ingress and egress by means of a public street or road. Adjacent and contiguous lots of record may be combined for building development only after review and approval by the Planning Commission. No structure may be erected across a recorded lot line unless the lots in question are resubdivided and such resubdivision is recorded with the Clerk of Court.

Addition - Section 5.302.12

All subdivision proposals greater than 50 lots or 5 acres, whichever is lesser, shall include base flood elevation data. "Base flood" means the flood having a one-percent chance of being equalled or exceeded in any given year.
