

ORDINANCE NO. 1067

An ordinance making it unlawful for any person other than a licensed physician to tattoo any human being; providing the penalty for violation thereof; providing for the repeal of ordinances in conflict herewith; and providing for the severability of this ordinance.

SECTION 1. No person other than a licensed physician shall tattoo or otherwise cause any indelible mark or figure to be fixed upon the body of a human being.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding Thirty (30) days or by both such fine and imprisonment within the discretion of the Court. Each day any violation of any provision of this ordinance continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. If any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.
