

ORDINANCE 1068

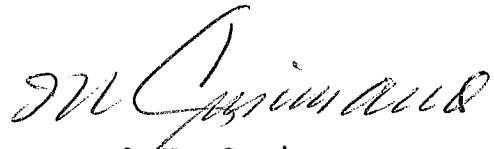
An Ordinance amending Section 4-23 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell and City Ordinance No. 954.

Be it enacted by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell and City Ordinance 954 adopted November 12, 1974 be changed to read:

Section 4-23:

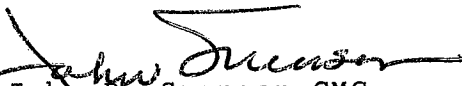
Any animal caught in violation of this article may be caught and impounded. If the animal is wearing a tag showing a name and address, the owner shall immediately be notified by written notice at the last known address that the animal has been seized and impounded. If the animal is not wearing a tag, no notification need be given. Unless the owner claims the animal and pays the fee then in effect for catching the animal and the fee then in effect for each day of impoundment within three (3) days the animal may be disposed of at public auction or otherwise.
