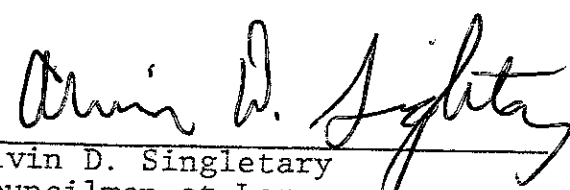

15 1978-1979 was not adopted prior to the end of the fiscal year,
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17 and it is expressly found that the adoption of a budget does

19 effect the life, public health and public safety, to the
20
21 extent that no expenditures can be made without authorized
22
23 appropriations, and in order to authorize appropriations, and
24
25 in order to operate the city functions, it is necessary to
26
27 adopt a budget immediately for only the maintenance, administration
28
29 and operating of normal functions of government.
