PROCEDURE FOR INTRODUCTION AND
CONSIDERATION OF ORDINANCES

A. All proposed ordinances shall be introduced in typewritten form and shall be double spaced on legal size paper, with a left-hand margin of not less than one and one-quarter inches, a right-hand margin of not less than three-eighths of an inch, a margin at the top of not less than two inches and a margin at the bottom of not less than one inch.

B. Each line of the left-hand margin of a proposed ordinance shall be numbered consecutively (i.e., 1, 2, 3, etc.).

C. Each paragraph of a proposed ordinance shall be indented one inch from the left-hand margin.

D. All proposed ordinances shall be confined to one subject expressed clearly in the title.

E. All amendments to proposed ordinances shall be germane.

F. All amendments to a proposed ordinance shall be introduced in typewritten form and shall be double spaced on legal size paper, with a left-hand margin of not less than one and one-quarter inches, a right-hand margin of not less than three eights of an inch, a margin at the top of not less than two inches, and a margin at the bottom of not less than one inch.

G. Each line of the left-hand margin of an amendment to a proposed ordinance shall be numbered consecutively.

H. Each paragraph of an amendment to a proposed ordinance shall be indented one inch from the left-hand margin.

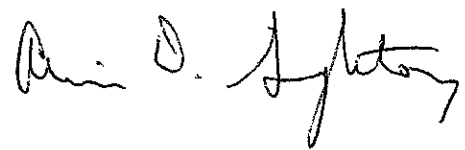
I. A proposed ordinance or an amendment to a proposed ordinance shall bear the name or names of the author or authors.

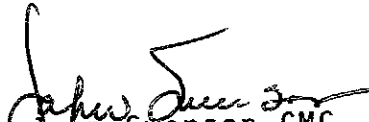
J. At least fifteen (15) copies of each proposed ordinance or amendment to a proposed ordinance shall be prepared by the Clerk of Council. One copy shall be furnished to each Council member and the Mayor. Two (2) copies shall be retained by the Clerk. A copy shall be furnished to each member of the media that is present and the Clerk may prepare as many additional copies as he deems appropriate to furnish to members of the public.

K. Except for emergency ordinances, no ordinance shall be considered for final passage until it has laid over at least fourteen (14) days from its publication and unless a public hearing has been held on the ordinance.
