ORDINANCE
NO. 1100

An ordinance amending Ordinance 1080.

Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of
Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that Ordinance
1080, adopted September 12, 1978, be changed to add:

7. An official bid list shall be maintained by the
City's Purchasing Department and shall be updated from time to
time by advertising for interested bidders in the following news-
papers: Slidell Daily Sentry, Slidell Daily Times, The
St. Tammany Banner, The New Orleans States-Item, The Times-
Picayune, and The Morning Advocate, by placing a one-eighth
(1/8) page advertisement on the second week in January and July
of each year, soliciting all qualified parties interested in
doing business with the City of Slidell, to furnish: nature of
business, address, and telephone number.

In no way does this ordinance alter, or replace the
requirements listed in the State of Louisiana's Bid Law, or the
City of Slidell's Charter.

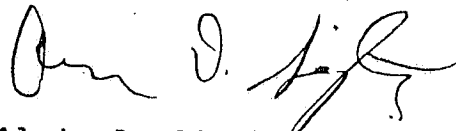
AMENDMENT

as follows:

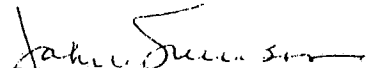
On line 24, change one-quarter (1/4) to read one-eighth

Subject: Ordinance #1100 - Mayor's Veto

Gentlemen:

I firmly believe that when an ordinance is adopted by the legislative branch, funding for that ordinance should be considered. According to our investigation and computations, the cost of implementing subject ordinance would be approximately \$4,500.00 per year. These funds are not provided for in the FY-79 budget.

We believe that the City Buyer, by advertising in the Daily Journal of Commerce which is published in New Orleans and distributed over the entire State of Louisiana, and a large part of Mississippi, and read by contractors, architects and vendors of all types of goods and services as required by the city, will be able to attract an appropriate amount of bidders.

It is also our suggestion that the City Buyer advertise in this particular journal for a list of prospective bidders. In six months to a year, if this system is not proving satisfactory, I will not be opposed to trying the provisions provided for in Ordinance #1100.

For the above reasons, I hereby veto Ordinance #1100 and respectfully request your concurrence.

This is to advise that the City Council at their meeting held last evening did not readopt Ordinance No. 1100, vetoed by you, therefore, the Ordinance is not adopted.

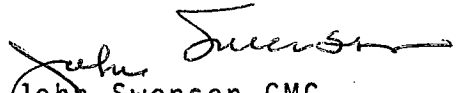
