ORDINANCE

NO. 1115

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of two and sixty-three one hundredth (2.63) mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1979.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a tax of two and sixty-three one hundredth (2.63) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1978.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said tax is levied for the purpose or maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1979, all as authorized by the Special Taxpayer Election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, September 28th, 1974.
