ORDINANCE

NO. 1117

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levy-
ing a special tax of forty (.40) one hundredths mill on the
dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana,
sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the Water Works
Public Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for
the year 1979.

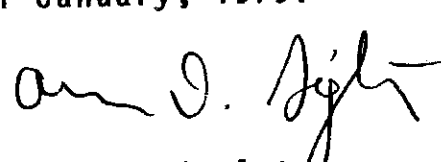
SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Councilmen
of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that
there is hereby levied a special tax of forty (.40) one hundredths
mill on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the
State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell according to
the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1978.

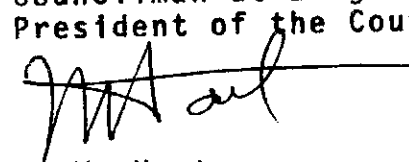
SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special
tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient
to pay interest and maturing bonds of the Water Works Public
Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year
1979, as duly authorized by a Resolution of the Mayor and Board
of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 28th
day of April, 1958.

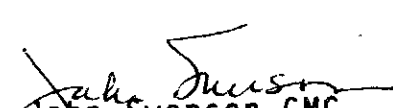
