ORDINANCE

NO. 1137

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OR REMOVAL OF OPENED
OR UNSEALED METAL OR GLASS BEVERAGE CONTAINERS FROM BARS OR
LOUNGES IN THE CITY OF SLIDELL, AND RESTRICTING THE CONSUMPTION
OF BEVERAGES FROM METAL OR GLASS CONTAINERS.

1. The removal of any opened or unsealed metal or
glass beverage container from the premises of any bar or lounge
located in the City of Slidell is prohibited, except for the
removal of empty containers in connection with trash and garbage
disposal, glass and metal recycling programs, or the exchange of
returnable bottles.

2. The sale of any beverage in an opened or unsealed
metal or glass container from a bar or lounge for consumption
outside the premises of the bar or lounge is prohibited.

3. The consumption of any beverage packaged in a
metal or glass container is prohibited within 500 feet from the
entrance or exit of a bar or lounge.

4. The consumption of any beverage packaged in a
metal or glass container is prohibited on public parking lots
within the City of Slidell.

5. Any person found violating Section 1, 2, 3, or 4
of this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$100.00.
