ORDINANCE

NO. 1140

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a copy of a resolution passed by the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury from Lamar Richardson, Jr. stating no objections to the City of Slidell incorporating a Parish-owned road right-of-way.

WHEREAS, Slidell Planning Commission in a letter dated January 18, 1979, recommended approval of such an annexation;

WHEREAS, by publication in the Slidell Daily Sentry News, February 1-8-15-16-22 & 25, 1977, the Council gave notice of their intention to take action on said petition by calling a Public Hearing on February 28, 1979, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the following described road right-of-way be annexed and become part of the City of Slidell:

From the Section corner common to Section 1,2,11, and 12 Twp. 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana proceed East one hundred twenty (120.) feet to a point, thence South  $0^{\circ} 46' 50''$  East forty-four point ninety-three (44.93) feet to a point, the point of beginning. From the point of beginning the right-of-way shall be thirty (30) feet each side of the following. From the point of beginning proceed S.  $00^{\circ} 46' 50''$  E. a distance of twelve hundred (1200.) feet to a point, thence N.  $89^{\circ} 08' 07''$  E. a distance of five hundred thirty-three point twenty-eight (533.28) feet to a point, thence S.  $00^{\circ} 46' 50''$  E. a distance of one thousand (1000.) feet to a point which is the southern end of the right-of-way.
