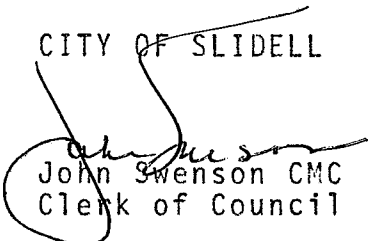
PUBLIC NOTICE

RE: Recommendation and Action by the Slidell Planning Commission

Gentlemen:

At the regular meeting of the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission held on January 15, 1979, the following action was taken:

a. 2-151: A request of the Church of God in Louisiana for rezoning of Lots 1-8 & Lot 16, Square 33, Pine Park Place Subdivision, from A-8 High Density Urban to C-2 Neighborhood Commercial for property located on the southeast corner of Eighth Street and Fremaux Avenue. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommends denial of this rezoning request.

b. Z79-1: A request by B.E. McDaniel et.al. for rezoning from A-9 Apartment District to A-4 Transitional for property generally located west of Seventh Street and north of Gause Blvd. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommends approval of this rezoning request. 79-1-13

c. A79-1: City Initiated: Proposed annexation of Lindbergh Drive from Gause Blvd. to its intersection with the service road along I-10. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommends approval of this proposed annexation. - 79-1-14

d. A79-2: City Initiated: Proposed annexation of the I-10 service road from Gause Blvd. to its intersection with Lindbergh Drive. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommends approval of this proposed annexation. 79-1-15

e. An amendment to Section 1.103 of the Zoning Ordinance so that the zoning map will be kept by the Director of Planning. The Planning and Zoning Commission initiated this Zoning Ordinance amendment and recommends approval of the amendment. - 79-1-16
