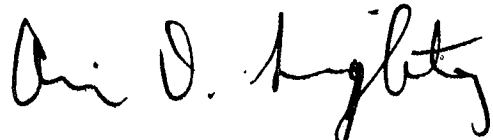
An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, closing Brewster Street.

WHEREAS, Slidell Planning Commission in a letter dated January 18, 1979, recommended the closing of Brewster Street from Eleventh Street to the W-14 Division Canal.

WHEREAS, by publication in the Slidell Daily Sentry News, February 8th, 15th, and 22nd, 1979, the Council gave notice of their intention to take action on said street closing by calling a Public Hearing on February 28, 1979, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that Brewster Street from Eleventh Street to the W-14 Division Canal is not needed for public use and the street be closed and the right-of-way be split between the adjoining property owners.
