ORDINANCE

NO. 1146

MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES CIVIL SERVICE PAY PLAN

AN ORDINANCE amending and restating Ordinance Number 1085, adopted September 26, 1978, a pay plan for Municipal Employees Civil Service of the City of Slidell, to provide for the severability of the provisions of this ordinance and to repeal all ordinances in conflict herewith by changing Class Codes 0083, 0084 and adding Class Codes 0072, 0073 and 0704.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL of the City of Slidell, Louisiana in legal session convened, that:

SECTION 1. The pay plan for the Municipal Employees Civil Service of the City of Slidell is hereby enacted as follows:

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

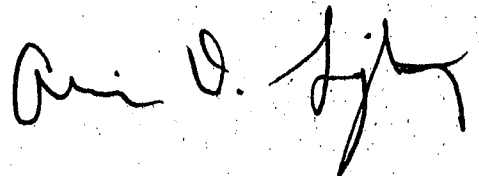

SECTION 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective as provided by the Slidell City Charter adopted August 22nd, 1977.

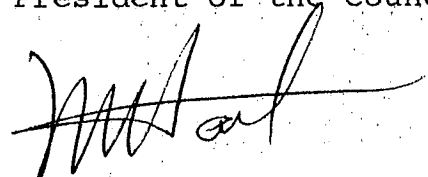

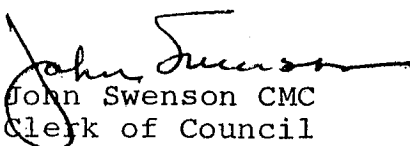

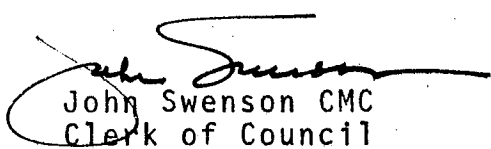
