ORDINANCE

NO. 1152

An ordinance amending Sections 4.14 and 4.23 of the
Code of Ordinances and Ordinance 954.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council, in legal session
convened, that the following be added to Sections 4.14 and 4.23
of the Code of Ordinances and Ordinance 954, adopted
November 12, 1974.

Section 4-14. Add the following:

It shall also be unlawful for any owner to own, possess,
harbor, or keep a dog or cat within the corporate limits, unless
such animal, if over the age of three months, is licensed. Such
license to be issued at the time of inoculation for rabies by a
licensed veterinarian or by duly authorized personnel at the
Slidell Humane Shelter, upon being shown proof of inoculation.
License fee shall be \$2.00. Exception: Persons over 60 years of
age shall pay a fee of \$1.00. License calendar shall run from
May 1 through April 30, each year. Licensed veterinarians assist-
ing in the administration of this program will be paid fifty (50¢)
cents for their services for each license they issue. All fees
collected will be administered and accounted for by the Slidell
Humane Society, and will be given to the Director of Finance on
a periodic basis for inclusion in the General Fund of the City
of Slidell. License fees shall, after payment of the necessary
costs of collection and the cost of operating the pound, be de-
posited to the credit of the St. Tammany Parish School Fund. It
shall be the responsibility of the Slidell Humane Society to see
that the licenses and tags are issued and the ordinance enforced.
The license must be attached to the animal's collar or harness.
If at any time said tag is lost, a new tag may be obtained for
a charge of \$1.00 at the Slidell Humane Shelter upon showing

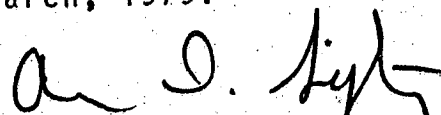

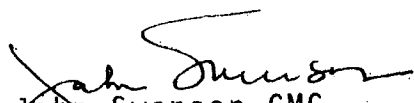
Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of

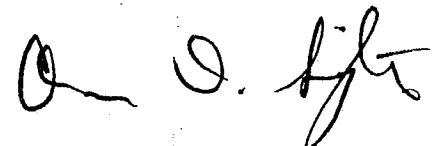
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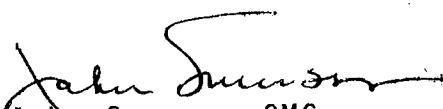
BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of

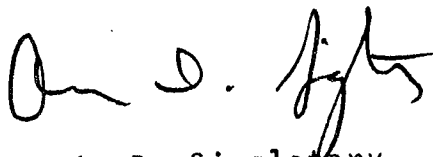

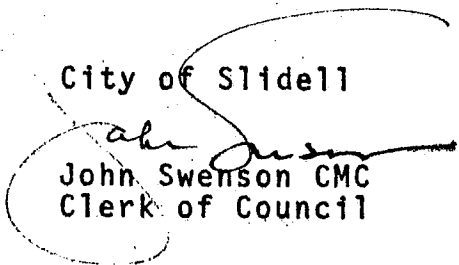
PUBLIC NOTICE
