ORDINANCE

NO. 1153

APPOINTMENTS TO BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENTS BY MAYOR

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell
that all appointments to the Board of Zoning Adjustments, City of
Slidell, shall be made in accordance with the following provisions:

a) All members appointed to the Board of Zoning
Adjustments shall actually reside and be legally domiciled within
the City limits of Slidell.

b) All members appointed to the Board of Zoning
Adjustments shall be legally registered voters of the City of
Slidell.

c) Each member of the City Council may submit not more
than three (3) names to the Mayor for consideration for appoint-
ment to the Board of Zoning Adjustments.

d) From the names submitted by the City Council, the
Mayor shall appoint members in such a manner so as to provide, as
far as possible, for representation from all seven (7)
Councilmanic Districts.

e) Each City Council member submitting nominations
shall submit nominations to the Mayor within two (2) weeks of the
adoption of this ordinance. This original pool of nominations
shall be used to fill any vacancy on the Board of Zoning
Adjustments at the time of the adoption of this ordinance. There-
after, the Mayor shall call for a new pool of nominations from
the Council whenever a vacancy exists on the Board. Each City
Council member submitting nominations shall submit their nomi-
nations to the Mayor within two (2) weeks of the call and the
Mayor shall make his appointment(s) within thirty (30) days of the
call.

f) Whenever a vacancy exists on the Board, if it be
a regular member's seat, as opposed to an alternate member's

1 seat, the Mayor shall fill the vacancy with a member from a
2 Councilmanic District which had not been previously represented
3 by a regular member.
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6 g.) A member is declared no longer a member of this
7 Board and chairman shall notify the Mayor and City Council of
8 vacancy or vacancies within ten (10) days of:
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11 1. Absence by any regular member as opposed to
12 an alternate member for two (2) consecutive regular meetings.
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14 2. Absence by any regular member as opposed to an
15 alternate member for three (3) consecutive meetings provided at
16 least one of these meetings is due to illness and reported to
17 chairman by call or letter within seven (7) days before or seven
18 (7) days after absence.
