Gentlemen and Mrs. Wood:

I am returning to you Ordinance #1174 with my veto of line item #42 and this would revise line item #18 Undedicated Surplus to read \$70,000, in lieu of \$48,000 as it presently reads.

I am reluctantly vetoing this item because, in theory, I feel it may be a good program; however, there are so many unanswered questions I feel it would be irresponsible for me not to express my concern.

- I was not presented with any format for the Boxing Program.
- The line item does not indicate whose responsibility it would be to administer the program, however, I assume it would come under the responsibility of the Recreation Director with a possible sponsorship by the Police Department.
- I have endeavored to obtain insurance costs from our insurance carrier, but due to the lack of information that I could give him, I have been unable to determine this cost, however, I expect it to be somewhat high.

If the questions that have been raised in this veto message can be answered to everyone's satisfaction, I would strongly consider supporting this program.

Gentlemen and Mrs. Wood:

As stated in my letter to you dated June 22, I vetoed the captioned program reluctantly because it does seem to have merit. However, there are several questions that I feel must be answered for us to proceed in a responsible manner. Our insurance carrier has asked some questions and I am asking some others:

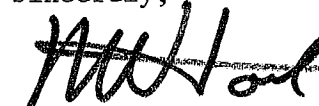
1. What is the area and number of floors to be occupied?
2. Are there any chairs and will they be left in or removed?
3. Will we have public exhibitions, and if so how many people can be admitted, and will we charge for admission?
4. Assuming that the building will be converted to a gym, what equipment will we have in it?
5. Who is going to supervise the program and how many supervisors?
6. What is the age of the participants and the number of participants?
7. What are the hours that the gym will be open?
8. What protective equipment will participants be provided with?
9. Will any pro or semi-pro fighters train and if so who will their trainers and managers be?

10. Since this program is being funded out of a surplus, it is my opinion that it should not be a reoccurring expenditure. Therefore, we need to know the amount, if any, of reoccurring costs.
11. The budget amendment only provides for a program, it does not specify any particular department budget amendment. I would assume that this would come under the Recreational Department budget with the sponsorship by the Police Department. This needs to be cleared up.

In view of the foregoing questions, I would ask that my veto be substained or at least tabled until these questions can be answered.
