ORDINANCE NO. 1189

An Ordinance amending Section 7-9 of the Slidell Code of Ordinances and establishing a fee for the reinspection of all licensed work in the City of Slidell.

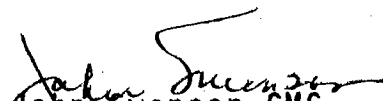
BE IT HEREBY ENACTED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Section 7-9 of the Slidell Code of Ordinances be amended to include a paragraph (e) to read as follows:

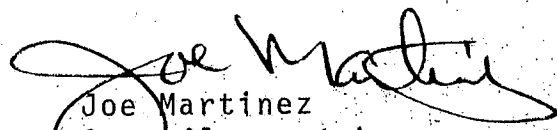
When a City inspector finds an installation, building or project that does not meet City codes, he shall so note on the permit or inspection sheet. The license holder of his designee shall make application at the Slidell Permit Office for a reinspection upon paying a fee of \$10. The inspector shall then proceed to re-examine the installation to see that it complies with City codes. This shall apply to all fields, including building, electrical, ACHMRV, gas and plumbing.

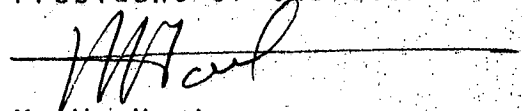

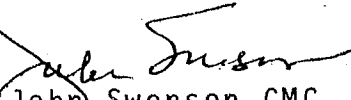
