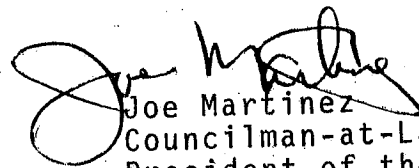
An Ordinance undedicating a portion of Roosevelt Street.

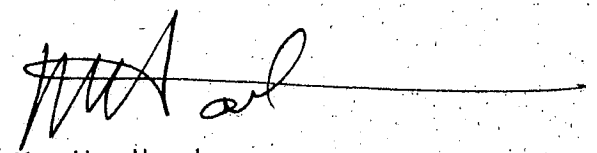
BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the portion of Roosevelt Street, from its intersection with Eleventh Street to the city limit line (eastern boundary of Square 65, Pine Park Place Subdivision), is not needed for public use and be undedicated with the street right-of-way equally divided between adjoining property owners, except for a 20 foot strip being 10 feet from both sides of the centerline of Roosevelt Avenue from Eleventh Street to the W-14 Diversion Canal right-of-way.

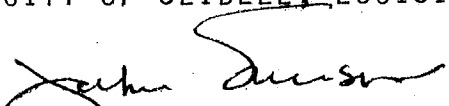

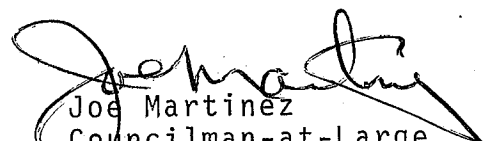
BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of

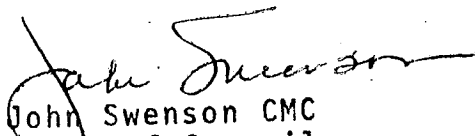
PUBLIC NOTICE

At the regular meeting of the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission held on June 18, 1979, the following action was taken:

79-6-76
a) 279-7: A request by Gloria Winn and Mae T. Whidbee for annexation and zoning to A-6 Single Family Urban for 4.577 acres of land generally located north of North Boulevard, east of Southern Railroad tracks and the W-14 Diversion Canal and south of Louisiana Power and Light company easement. (See information attached.) The Planning and Zoning Commission recommends approval of this annexation and zoning request.
