Commission.

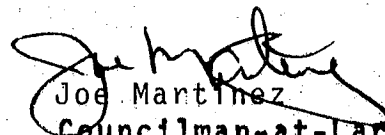

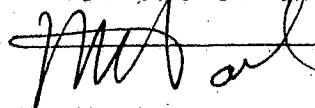

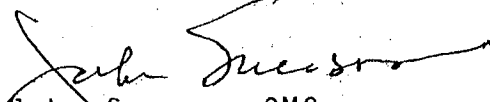
