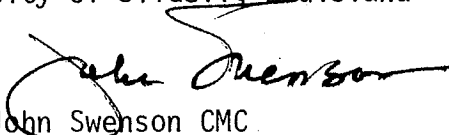
PUBLIC NOTICE

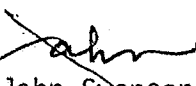
