ORDINANCE NO. 1950

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana levying a special tax of ten one hundredths (.10) mill on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1958 Fire Protection Public Improvements Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1987.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of ten one hundredths (.10) mill on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, according to the assessment of the said City for the year 1986.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the Fire Protection Public Improvements Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1987 as duly authorized by a special taxpayer election held July 23, 1957 and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 28th day of April, 1958.

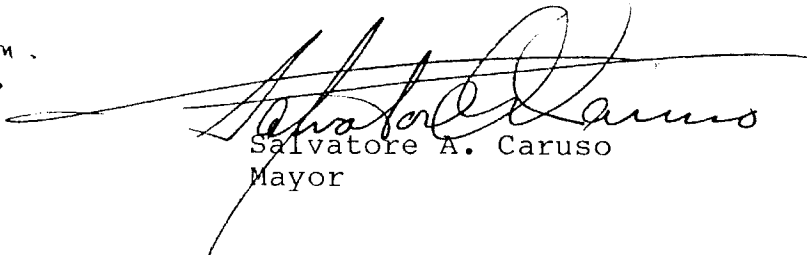

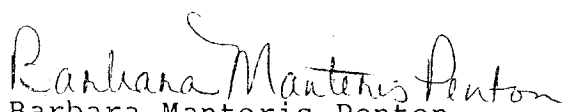
