**ORDINANCE NO. 2048**

An ordinance amending Chapter 2. Administration, Article II. Reserved\*, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell by naming Article II. and adding thereto Section 2-17. Employee Health Insurance, subsections 2-17.1 Definition of Full-Time Employee, and 2-17.2 Employer Contributions.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter 2. Administration, Article II. Reserved\* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is hereby amended as follows:

Title Article II. EMPLOYEE BENEFITS\*

Add Section 2-17., subsections 2-17.1 and 2-17.2 as follows:

**Sec. 2-17. Employee Health Insurance.**

It is hereby declared to be the policy and purpose of the City of Slidell to contribute to a program of health insurance for all full-time employees.

**Sec. 2-17.1. Definition of Full-Time Employee.**

A full-time employee is one who

- (1) Works on a regular, weekly basis at an assigned job for not less than thirty (30) hours per week.
- (2) Receives a minimum of \$6,000.00 per year in earned, paid salary or wages.
- (3) Holds employee status as a result of:
  - (a) being employed under the rules and conditions of and as an employee of either the Municipal or the Police Civil Service; or
  - (b) being an unclassified employee whose specific position is directly designated, approved and funded in accordance with the Home Rule Charter of the City of Slidell.

**Sec. 2-17.2. Employer Contributions.**

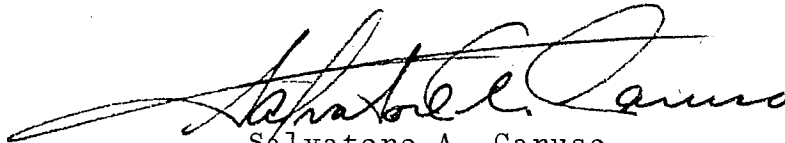
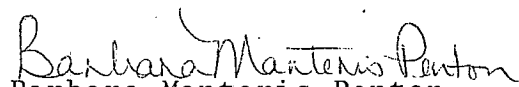
Employer contributions of the cost of health insurance for full-time employees shall be paid from amounts appropriated for such purpose by the Slidell City Council. It is declared to be the policy and purpose of the City of Slidell to contribute one-half (1/2) of the cost of health insurance for each eligible employee.

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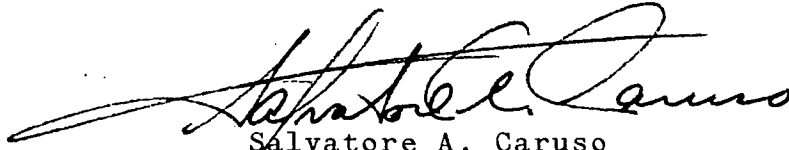

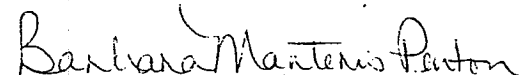

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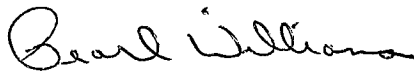
