Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing of same.

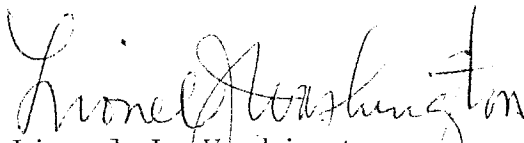
BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the

needed for public use:

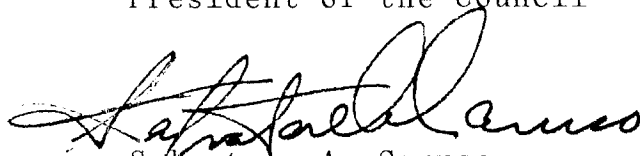
Unit #45 Chevy, 1 Ton Flat Bed, Serial No. CCY335A149641
