Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing of same.

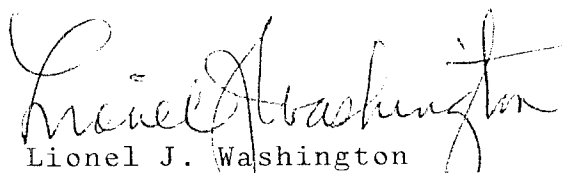
BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the

needed for public use.

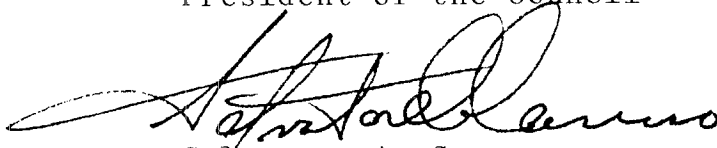
BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the following equipment shall
