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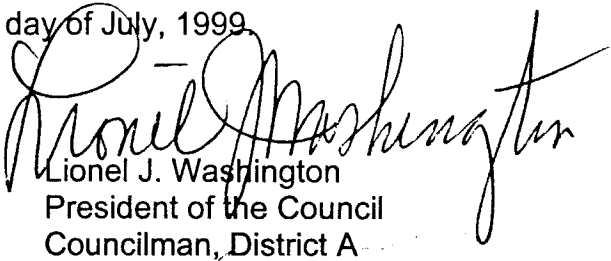
10 An ordinance proposing an amendment to Sections 2-01, 3-02 and 4-05 of the
11 Home Rule Charter regarding term limitations for the City Council Members, the Mayor and
12 the Chief of Police for the City of Slidell.

14 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
15 hereby call an election at which there shall be submitted to the electorate of the City of
16 Slidell for its approval or rejection a certain proposal to amend Sections 2-01, 3-02 and 4-05
17 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Slidell pertaining to the terms of the City Council
18 Members, the Mayor and the Chief of Police, as follows:

19 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that if the amendment is passed
20 by the voters of the City of Slidell, the Home Rule Charter shall be amended as follows:

- 21 1. In Section 2-01(B), the following language shall be deleted: "Effective with the term
22 of office beginning July 1, 1994, Council Members shall be limited to not more than
23 two (2) consecutive terms." and shall be replaced with the following: "Effective with
24 the term of office beginning July 1, 1990, Council Members shall be limited to not
25 more than three (3) consecutive terms.";
- 26 2. In Section 3-02, the following language shall be deleted: "Effective with the term of
27 office beginning July 1, 1994, the mayor shall be limited to not more than two (2)
28 consecutive terms." and shall be replaced with the following: "Effective with the term
29 of office beginning July 1, 1990, the mayor shall be limited to not more than three (3)
30 consecutive terms.";
- 31 3. In Section 4-05(B), the following language shall be deleted: "Effective with the term
32 of office beginning July 1, 1994, the chief of police shall be limited to not more than
33 two (2) consecutive terms." and shall be replaced with the following: "Effective with
34 the term of office beginning July 1, 1990, the Chief of Police shall be limited to not
35 more than three (3) consecutive terms."

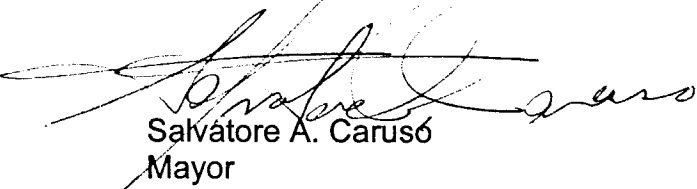
