5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3001**

7 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the
8 adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the
9 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police
10 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government,
11 as well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general
12 obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2002.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of
14 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate
15 tax of thirty-four and sixty-four one hundredths (34.64) mills on the dollar upon all
16 property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City,
17 according to the assessment roll of said City in the calendar year 2001.
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20 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
21 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:
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23 A tax of 6.18 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues to
24 pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal
25 and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2002, as shown by the
26 budget for the year 2002, adopted by the City Council of said City. So authorized by
27 Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 6.18 mills.
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29 A tax of 3.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal
30 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2002. So authorized by
31 the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1984.
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33 A tax of 2.53 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal
34 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2002. So authorized by
35 the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.
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37 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in the
38 City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2002. So authorized by the special taxpayer
39 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.
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A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2002. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.

A tax of 2.46 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving public works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2002. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.

A tax of 4.54 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1994 General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2002, as authorized by a special election held November 8, 1988, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 8th day of March, 1994.

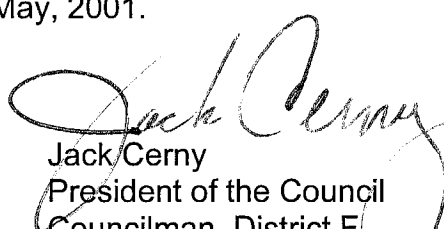
A tax of 5.93 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1996 General Obligation Bonds for the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2002, as authorized by a special election held November 18, 1995, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 12th day of September, 1995.

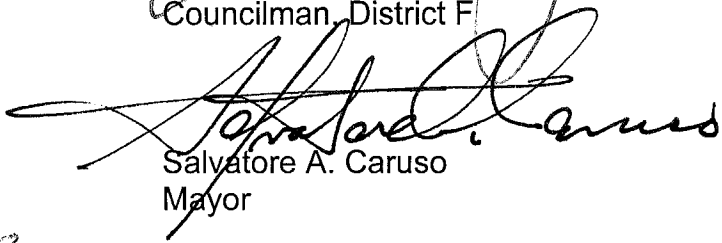
