

ORDINANCE NO. 499 B

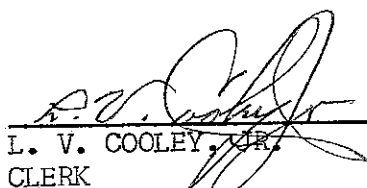
An ordinance of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, prohibiting parking on certain streets in the Town of Slidell, Louisiana.

SECTION 1: Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana in legal session convened that the parking of a vehicle of any kind or description on the west side of U. S. Highway No. 11 and U. S. Highway No. 190, from the end of curb to the south corner of the depot, for forty four feet (44') east of and forty four feet (44') north of the intersection of the property lines in the northeast quadrant of the intersection and on the south side of U. S. Highway No. 190 between Front Street and Second Street be and the same is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2: Be it further ordained that any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction be fined not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or be imprisoned for not longer than thirty (30) days, or be both fined and imprisoned at the discretion of the Mayor.

SECTION 3: Be it further ordained that any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: Be it further ordained that should any part of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional the part not declared unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect; and this ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage and promulgation.
