

ORDINANCE NO. 616

An ordinance of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, to extend and change the west corporation line of the Town of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that at the request of R.L. Dunham, C.E. Cunningham, P.D. Pravata and George E. Reine, Jr., the owners of the property involved, a portion of the south corporation line, the west corporation line and the north corporation line of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, changed to include the property situated or located within the following change of the corporate limits of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana.

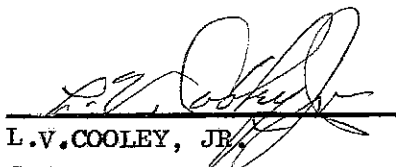
Approximately 55 acres of land, lying and being situated in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 4 T 9 S R 14 E 9th Ward, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, more fully described as follows, to wit:

From the one quarter section corner common to Sections 4 and 9 of said Township and Range go thence west along the north edge of West Hall Avenue a distance of 345.2 feet; thence north 1111 feet; thence north 73 degrees east 311.7 feet; thence north 0 degrees 45 minutes west 506 feet; thence north 73 degrees east 1021.8 feet; thence south approximately 1252 feet to the center of Bayou St. Benedict; thence follow the center line of said Bayou St. Benedict approximately 740 feet to the east line of Bayou Vincent, which is the present west corporate line of the Town of Slidell; thence following the left descending bank of Bayou Vincent along the west corporate line of Slidell approximately 200 feet to the Section line between Sections 4 and 9; thence west along said section line 1480 feet, more or less, to the point of departure. All indicated by the red boundary on attached blueprint, dated April 27, 1959. It further being noted that part of the 55 acres described above is known as Carolyn Park Subdivision according to map of survey dated September 13, 1956 by Lamar P. Harrison, and further approved by St. Tammany Parish Police Jury on April 7, 1959, also attached hereto.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage and promulgation.
