

ORDINANCE NO. 619

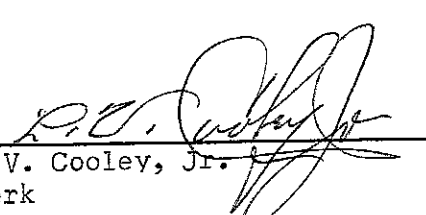
An ordinance to provide revenue for the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, for the purpose of paying and defraying the general expenses of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, for the general and local purposes for the year 1960.

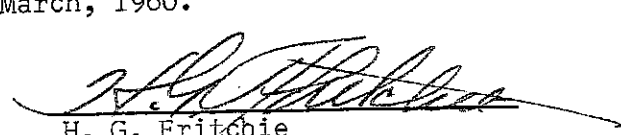
SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the following millage is hereby levied on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana which is situated in the corporate limits of the Town of Slidell and according to the Assessment Roll of the said Town for the year 1959, which assessment roll is now on file in the office of the Clerk and Tax Collector of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, to-wit:

Seven mills on the dollar for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenue to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal and local purposes of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1960 as shown by the budget for the year 1960 adopted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage and promulgation.

ORDINANCE NO. 620

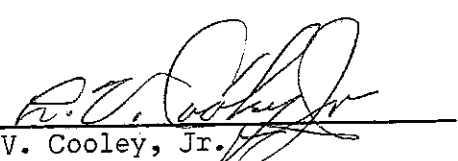
An ordinance of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of two and seventy-five one hundredths (2.75) mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the Town Hall bonds of the Town of Slidell, for the year 1960.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of 2.75 mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the Town of Slidell according to the assessment roll of the said Town for the year 1959.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the Town Hall bonds for the Town of Slidell for the year 1960, as duly authorized by a resolution of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 27th of January, 1953.

SECTION 3. Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage and promulgation.
