

ORDINANCE NO. 623

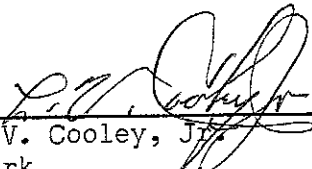
An ordinance of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) on the dollar on all taxable property in the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the Fire Protection Public Improvement Bonds of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1960.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the Town of Slidell, according to the assessment roll of the said Town for the year 1959.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the Fire Protection Public Improvement Bonds of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1960, as duly authorized by a resolution of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 28th day of April, 1958.

SECTION 3. Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage and promulgation.

ORDINANCE NO. 624

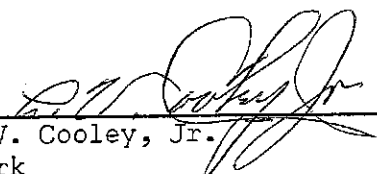
An ordinance of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of four and seventy-five one hundredths (4.75) mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the Water Works Public Improvement Bonds of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1960.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that thereis hereby levied a special tax of 4.75 mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the Town of Slidell according to the assessment roll of the said Town for the year 1959.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the Waterworks Public Improvement Bonds of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1960, as duly authorized by a resolution of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 28th day of April, 1958.

SECTION 3. Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage and promulgation.
