

ORDINANCE NO. 638

An ordinance regulating the use of bicycles within the corporate limits of the Town of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, fixing the penalty for the violation thereof.

Section One

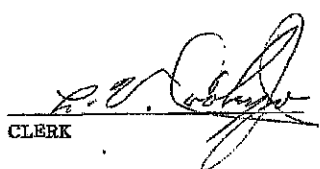
BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, with a quorum present, that it shall be unlawful for anyone to ride or use a bicycle within the corporate limits of the Town of Slidell without first registering same with the Police Department of the Town and securing a seal or certificate of registration from the said Department.

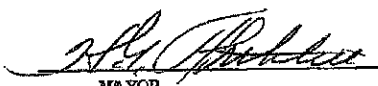
BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that there shall be a charge of fifty cents per registration, which shall be borne by the registrant.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the ^{first} registration shall be effective for one year beginning January 1, 1962 and expiring January 1, 1963, and regardless of the date the bicycle is registered the registration shall expire on the first day of the following January.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that anyone violating this ordinance shall be fined ~~a~~ a sum not exceeding \$100.00 and/or imprisoned for a period not exceeding 30 days, with 30 days additional in the event of nonpayment of the fine or both at the discretion of the Mayor.
