

RESOLUTION NO. 648 ✓

BE IT KNOWN, that at a legal meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell held at its office in the Municipal Auditorium on February 6, 1962 with a quorum present the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

WHEREAS the Town of Slidell has extended its corporate limits several instances since the last municipal election and

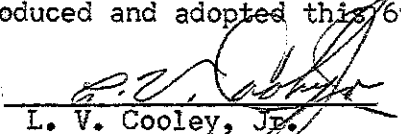
WHEREAS the Police Jury of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana has not seen fit to establish a new polling precinct within the corporate limits of the municipality as extended and

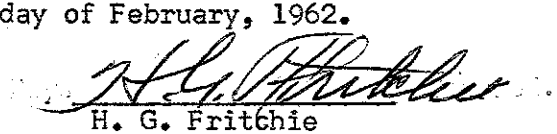
WHEREAS under present conditions the voters living in the annexed area, although being in the corporate limits, are being deprived of their vote in the municipal election

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen that the qualified voters living in the annexed area to the corporate limits of the Town of Slidell be and are now hereby permitted to vote in municipal elections at the established polling precincts nearest to their place of residence within the corporate limits.

This privilege is extended, of course, only provided the voters are otherwise legally qualified.
