

RESOLUTION NO. 651

WHEREAS, the Police Jury of St. Tammany Parish in trying to meet the excessive demands of the accelerating population increases in the southeast section of the Parish composed of the Fifth through the Ninth Wards inclusive particularly in the centers of Lacombe, Pearl River and Slidell, and

WHEREAS, the population of Slidell alone has increased over 100% since 1954 and is accelerating, and

WHEREAS, said Police Jury consistent with its policy of rendering every service possible to its citizenry, and

WHEREAS, said Police Jury has authorized the Registrar of Voters to engage a clerk and equip the office at the expense of the Police Jury, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Slidell does hereby agree to furnish the office space and all utilities, and

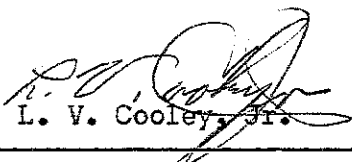
WHEREAS, the constantly increasing demands of this population explosion on the general funds of the Police Jury and Slidell make even the reasonable outlay for the Slidell Registrar's Office a serious burden, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That Senator B.B. Rayburn and Representative Jesse D. McLain be and they are hereby requested to endeavor to obtain from the State of Louisiana Legislature, at its next session, the authority for the Registrar of Voters to appoint a second permanent Deputy Registrar of Voters to be situated in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Senator Rayburn and Representative McLain endeavor to obtain from the State such financial aid in the operation of the Slidell Registrar Office as may be legally possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to Honorable Senator B.B. Rayburn, Honorable Representative Jesse D. McLain, Police Jury of St. Tammany Parish, Registrar of Voters Association and Honorable Thomas F. Steele, Registrar of Voters.
