

RESOLUTION NO. 652 ✓

BE IT KNOWN, That at a legal meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, held at the Town Hall, Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, on Wednesday, March 7th, 1962, at 7:30 P.M. with a quorum present, on motion made by Alderman L.E. Abney and seconded by Alderman Fred Honaker, the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

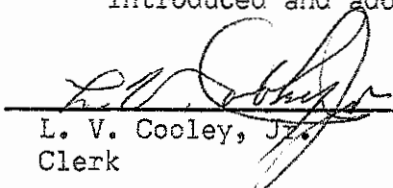
WHEREAS, the last official census of the Town of Slidell shows a population of said Town to be in excess of five thousand inhabitants, and

WHEREAS, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, when a Town's population exceeds five thousand, it is entitled to be designated as a city, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Honorable James H. Davis, Governor of the State of Louisiana, be and he is hereby requested to issue a proclamation proclaiming Slidell to be henceforth designated as a city and to take whatever steps are necessary for change of status.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Honorable Governor of the State of Louisiana, a copy given to the press of Slidell and a copy spread on the minutes.
