

ORDINANCE NO. 660

LOUISIANA
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL, ENLARGING THE BOUNDARIES OF
SAID CITY TO INCLUDE THE PROPOSED SUBDIVISION KNOWN AS STELLAR HEIGHTS.

WHEREAS the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, the governing body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of Tuesday, June 5, 1962, a petition from George E. Reine to extend the corporate limits of the City of Slidell to include certain property therein described and known as Stellar Heights Subdivision and;

WHEREAS said governing body did investigate and did find that said George E. Reine was the sole owner of said subdivision and did give notice of a hearing on said petition to be held on the 18th day of June, 1962 at the City Hall at 7:30 P. M. by publication in the Slidell Times & Weekly News under date of June 7, 1962. That said hearing was held on said date and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

Section 1. THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana in legal session convened that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana be enlarged to include the following described property to-wit:

#1 All that certain piece or parcel of land containing 30 acres, more or less, lying and being situated in the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2 T 9 S R 14 E 8th Ward, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, and being more fully described and delineated as follows, to wit: From the NW corner of the said $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 2 T 9 S R 14 E go east 990 feet to the point of beginning. Thence continue east 990 feet to an iron pipe; thence go south 1320 feet to an iron pipe; thence go west 990 feet to an iron pipe; thence go north 1320 feet to the point of beginning.

#2 All that certain piece or parcel of land, together with all rights, ways, privileges, and appurtenances thereunto belonging or otherwise appertaining to, lying and being situated in Section 2 T 9 S R 14 E 8th Ward, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, and being more fully described and delineated as follows, to wit: Commencing at the NW corner of the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of section 2 T 9 S R 14 E and going south 69.1 feet to an iron pipe set on the center line of a 100 footright of way granted to the Louisiana Power and Light Company for a high power transmission line being north 38 degrees 30 minutes west 262.4 feet to an iron pipe set on the east right of way line of Louisiana State Highway no. 1092 thence go along said highway being north 52 degrees 45 minutes east 200 feet to an iron pipe; thence go south 257.1 feet to the point of departure.

All in accordance with plat of survey no. 3029 by John H. Sollberger, C.E., dated May 29, 1961.

Acquired by the said Reine as per COB 321, folio 565 of the official records of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

Further described as the proposed Stellar Heights Subdivision of the City of Slidell, Louisiana according to the map of said subdivision by John H. Sollberger, C.E. dated February 7, 1962.

Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all of the property as above described shall be included in and become a part of the said City of Slidell, Louisiana.

Section 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become operative thirty days after its publication.
