

ORDINANCE NO. 665

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, defining the crime of Gambling and providing a penalty for the commission of such crime.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

Section 1. Gambling is the intentional conducting, or directly assisting in the conducting, as a business, of any game, contest, lottery or contrivance whereby a person risks the loss of anything of value in order to realize a profit.

Section 2. Whoever commits the crime of gambling shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars, or imprisoned for not more than thirty days, or both.
