

Ordinance 668-A

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City to include 31.34 acres of land to be known as East Ridge Park.

WHEREAS the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality did receive at their regular meeting of Tuesday, November 6th 1962, a petition from Mrs. Lydia B. Soniat and Mrs. Edna B. Masich, owners of the property herein described;

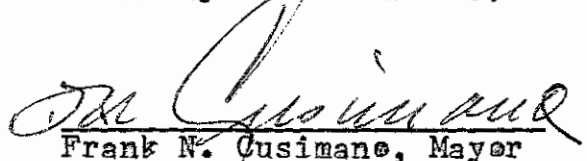
WHEREAS said governing body did investigate and did find that the said petitioners were the sole owners of said property and did give notice of a hearing on said petition to be held on December 3rd, 1962, at the City Hall by publication in the Slidell St. Tammany Times under date of November 22nd, 1962. That said hearing was held on said date and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

SECTION ONE: THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the South property line of Gause Road and the Parish Diversion Canal number W-14, run S 89° 52' E, 400 feet more or less to the NE corner of Broadmoor Subdivision: thence run South along the Easterly boundary of said Broadmoor Subdivision 2,579.28 feet: thence run S 89° 52' E 529.32 feet: thence run N 2,629.28 feet more or less to the North right of way line of said Gause Road: Thence run N 89° 52' W, 930 feet more or less along the North right of way of said Gause Road to the said Parish Diversion Canal number W-14; thence run in a Southerly direction 50 feet more or less along said Parish Diversion Canal number W-14 to the point of beginning.

SECTION TWO: THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that all of the property as above described shall be included in and become a part of the said City of Slidell, Louisiana.
