

The following ordinance was introduced by Alderman

ORDINANCE 680

An ordinance enlarging the boundaries of the City of Slidell,
describing the area to be annexed and added thereto, and the
new boundaries of said municipality.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of
Slidell, that:

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Herman S. Kohlmeyer, Sr., Mrs. Marie E. K.
Wolf, and Herman S. Kohlmeyer, Jr., have been shown to be the sole owners
of the following described property, to-wit:

A parcel of ground beginning 1420 feet west of the section
corner common to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, Township 9 South,
Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

From the point of beginning go West 2540 feet to the west
boundary of the property acquired by Marie E. Kohlmeyer and
Herman S. Kohlmeyer, from Peter Pravata on April 8, 1953,
by deed recorded COB 217 Folio 476; thence South 1285 feet
to an iron corner; thence East 2540 feet; thence North 1320
feet to the point of beginning, all as shown on a survey of
Russell P. Morgan, Deputy Parish Surveyor, dated July 30,
1957.

WHEREAS the said sole owners have by a petition, which is on file
in the office of the Secretary of the City of Slidell, petitioned the Mayor
and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, to annex said parcel
and enlarge the boundaries of the City of Slidell by annexing to, adding to,
and including therein the above described property, and

WHEREAS said petition is accompanied by the certificate of the
duly elected and qualified Assessor for the Parish of St. Tammany, Louisiana,
showing that the said Mr. and Mrs. Herman S. Kohlmeyer, Sr., Mrs. Marie E. K.
Wolf, and Herman S. Kohlmeyer, Jr., are the current owners of all of the above
described property, and further certifying to the estimated valuation of said
property according to the assessment for the year 1962, and

WHEREAS notice of the petition of the said Mr. and Mrs. Herman S.
Kohlmeyer, Sr., Mrs. Marie E. K. Wolf and Herman S. Kohlmeyer, Jr., was duly
given by publication on the 11th day of April, 1963, in The Slidell-Times,
a weekly newspaper published at Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, having
general circulation in the City of Slidell, and

WHEREAS more than ten days have elapsed since the date of said

publication and no protest of any kind has been lodged with the City of Slidell, Louisiana,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, that the following described property, to-wit:

A parcel of ground beginning 1420 feet west of the section corner common to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

From the point of beginning go West 2540 feet to the west boundary of the property acquired by Marie E. Kohlmeyer and Herman S. Kohlmeyer, from Peter Pravata on April 8, 1953, by deed recorded COB 217, Folio 476; thence South 1285 feet to an iron corner; thence East 2540 feet; thence North 1320 feet to the point of beginning, all as shown on a survey by Russell P. Morgan, Deputy Parish Surveyor, dated July 30, 1957.

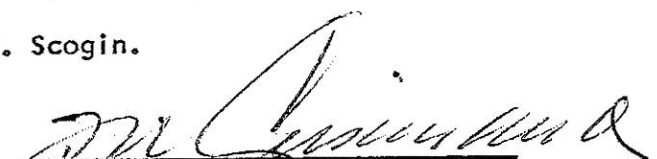
be and the same is hereby incorporated within the municipal limits and boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
