Slidell, more fully described as follows:

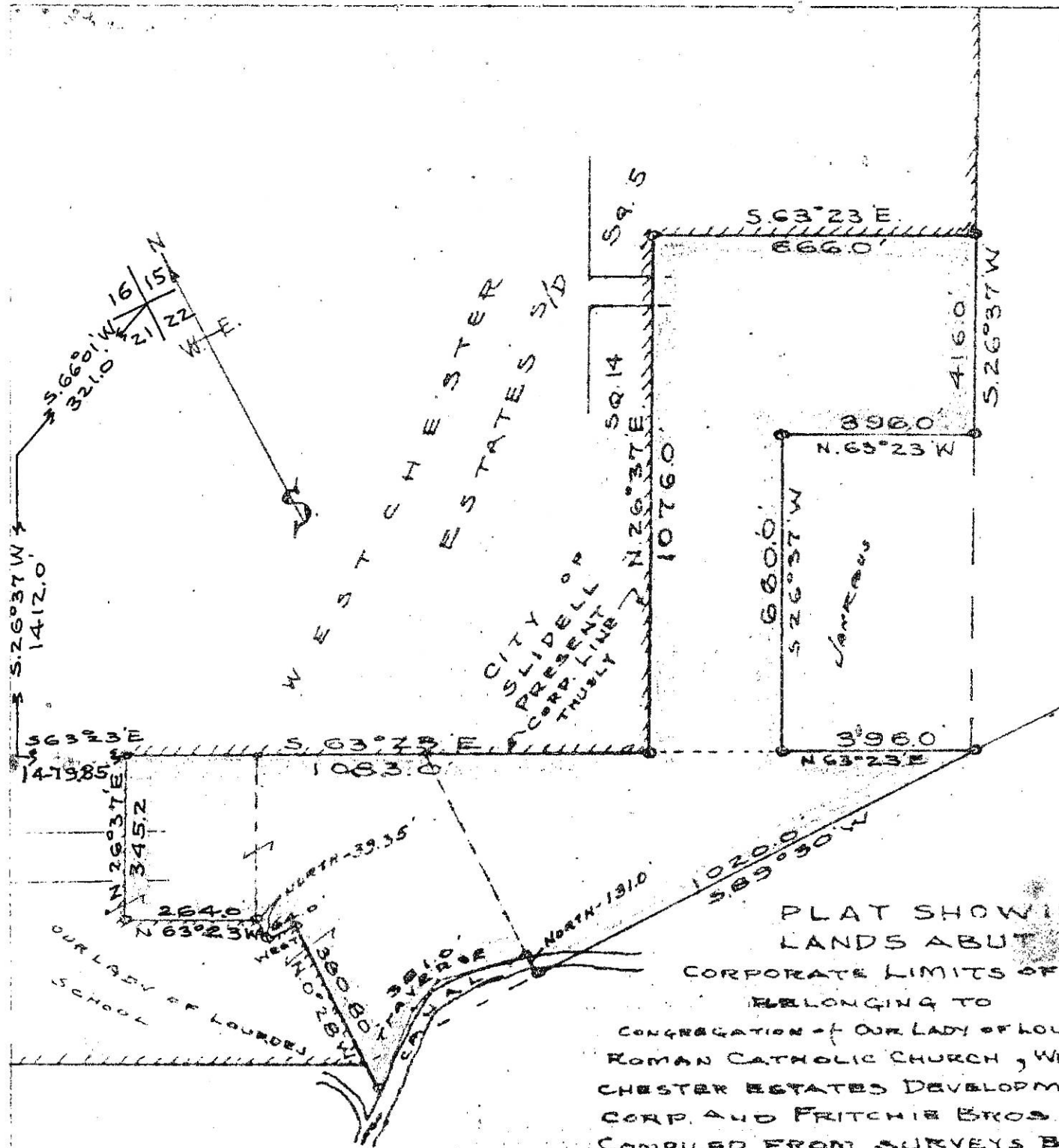
From the corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22 of said Township

South 63 degrees 23 minutes east 1083 feet; North 26 degrees 37
minutes east 1076 feet; South 63 degrees 23 minutes east 666 feet;
thence leaving the present corporation line and going south 26 degrees
37 minutes west 416 feet; thence north 63 degrees 23 minutes west 396
feet; thence south 26 degrees 37 minutes west 660 feet; thence south

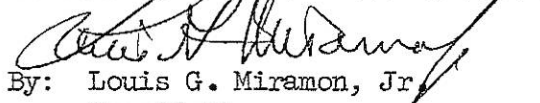

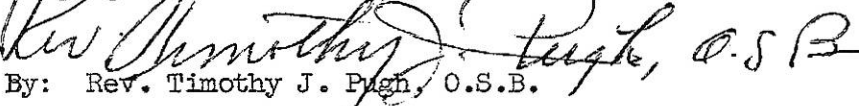
