

Ordinance No. 709

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City to include .83 acres of land.

WHEREAS the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of Tuesday April 7th, 1964, a petition from Harvey E. Gaines, requesting an enlargement of the present boundaries of the City of Slidell to include the following described property and;

WHEREAS said governing body did investigate and find that the said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of a hearing on said petition to be held on April 27th, 1964, at the City Hall by publication in the Slidell, St. Tammany Times under date of April 16th, 1964. That said hearing was held on said date and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

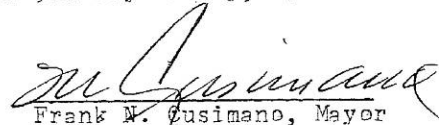
SECTION ONE: THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property to-wit:

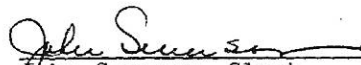
A certain parcel of land situated in the South West Quarter of Section 11, T9S, R14E, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, more fully described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing 24 chains East of the Northwest corner of the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section 11, T9S, R14E, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, at the South Edge of Fremaux Avenue and go thence East 330.0 feet along the South edge of Fremaux Avenue; thence go South 110.0 feet; thence go West 330.0 feet; thence go North 110.0 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION TWO: THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that all of the property as above described shall be included in and become part of the said City of Slidell, Louisiana.
