

ORDINANCE NO. 715

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City to include approximately eighteen acres of land.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of Tuesday, October 6th, 1964, a petition from Mr. George Reine, Jr., owner of the property herein described:

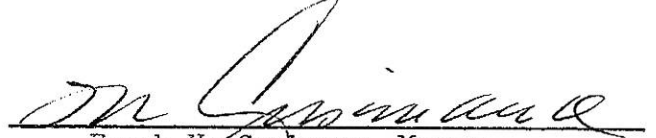
WHEREAS, said governing body did investigate and did find that the said petitioner is the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of said petition published in the Slidell St. Tammany Times under the date of October 12th, 1964, and as provided in public notice no one notified the City Clerk in writing of any objections by October 25th, 1964,

SECTION ONE. NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

From the intersection of Section 1 and 2, T 9 S, R 14 E and Sections 35 and 36, T 8 S, R 14 E St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, go South 2,638.60 ft. to a point; thence go North 89° 46' West, 4,081.63 ft. to the West right of way of Robert Road, being the point of beginning; thence continue North 89° 46' West, 1,199.67 ft; thence South 00° 02' East, 1,320.66 ft. to a point on the West right of way of Robert Road, thence go Northeasterly along the said right of way to point of beginning.

SECTION TWO. THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that all the property as above described shall be included in, and become part of, the said City of Slidell, Louisiana.
