

ORDINANCE NO. 735

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City to include 36.353 acres of land, more or less.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive at their regular monthly meeting of May 4th, 1965, a petition signed by Mr. Peter D. Pravata requesting an enlargement of the present boundaries of the City of Slidell to include the following described property, and;

WHEREAS, said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition to be held on May 24th, 1965, at the City Hall, as published in the Slidell-St. Tammany Times under date of May 13th, 1965. That said hearing was held on said date and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

SECTION ONE: THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen for the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property:

- #1 - Fourteen (14) acres of land situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, T 9 S R 14 E, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, to wit:

From the one-quarter corner between Sections 4 and 9 of T 9 S R 14 E St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana go along the south boundary of Section 4 a distance of 1055.7 feet; thence go North 0 degrees 45 minutes West 366.0 feet; thence go South 87 degrees West 100.0 feet; thence go North 0 degrees 45 minutes West 726.0 feet to the place of beginning:

Thence go North 1 degree 15 minutes West 525.0 feet; thence go North 87 degrees East 1311.5 feet to the west edge of the Bayou Bonfouca Canal; Then back at the said point of beginning and go North 87 degrees East 1169.0 feet to another point on the west edge of said Bayou Bonfouca Canal; then go in a northerly direction along the west edge of said Bayou Bonfouca Canal 558 feet, more or less, to complete the survey.

All in accordance with map of survey made by Lamar P. Harrison, C. E. dated August 14, 1963.

- #2 - All that certain piece or parcel of land together with the buildings and improvements thereon, and all rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, prescriptions, advantages and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in the Parish of St. Tammany and being 22.353 acres of land in Section 4, T 9 S R 14 E Greensburg District, Louisiana described as follows:

Begin at the one-quarter corner between Sections 4 and 9 T 9 S R 14 E Greensburg District, La. and run East along the South boundary of Section 4 1055.7 feet to an iron stob and the point of beginning:

Thence North 0 degrees 45 minutes West 366.0 feet to an iron stob; thence South 87 degrees 0 minutes West 100.0 feet to an iron stob; thence North 0 degrees 45 minutes West 726.0 feet to an iron stob; thence North 87 degrees 0 minutes East 1169.0 feet to an iron stob; on the bank of Bayou Bonfouca; thence continue North 87 degrees 0 minutes East to the middle of Bayou Bonfouca; thence recommence at the point of beginning and run East along the South boundary of Section 4 325.0 feet to the middle of Bayou Bonfouca; thence along the middle of said Bayou upstream to the point previously set in middle of Bayou Bonfouca. All in accordance with plat of survey by E. J. Champagne, dated August 11, 1955.

SECTION TWO: THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that all of the above property as described shall be included in, and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana. To be known as Carolyn Park Addition.
