

ORDINANCE NO. 736

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City to include 27.52 acres of land, more or less.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive at their regular monthly meeting of September 7th, 1965, a petition signed by the St. Tammany Parish School Board requesting an enlargement of the present boundaries of the City of Slidell to include the following described property, and;

WHEREAS, said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition to be held on September 25th, 1965, at the City Hall, as published in the Slidell-St. Tammany Times under date of September 9th, 1965. That said hearing was held on said date, and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

SECTION ONE: THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen for the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property:

- #1 - 13.02 acres of land lying and being situated in Section 44, T.9S., R.14 E., 9th Ward, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, more fully described as follows:

From the corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, T. 9 S., R. 14 East go South 66 degrees, 01 minutes West - 321 feet; thence South 26 degrees, 37 minutes West - 2100 feet to point "A"; thence South 63 degrees, 23 minutes East - 500 feet along the South line of Westchester Estates S/D to the point of beginning;

Thence continue South 63 degrees, 23 minutes East 1324.20 feet; thence South 26 degrees, 37 minutes West - 428.30 feet; thence North 63 degrees, 23 minutes West - 1324.20 feet; thence North 26 degrees, 37 minutes East - 428.30 feet to the point of departure.

The above property is subject to a 50 feet easement along the North line for drainage purposes granted to the Police Jury of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

Also a 25 foot easement along the south line of said drainage easement granted to Central Louisiana Electric Company and another drainage easement granted to St. Tammany Parish and designated on plat of survey as #W 20. All as shown on plat of survey by J. V. Burkes, C. E. #4690, dated February 12, 1965, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

- #2 - 14.50 acres of land lying and being situated in Section 44, T. 9 S., R. 14 E., 9th Ward, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, more fully described as follows:

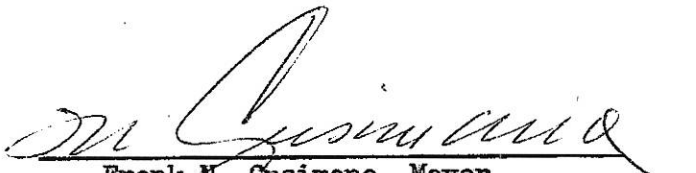
From the corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, T. 9 S., R. 14 East go South 66 degrees, 01 minutes West 321 feet; thence South 26 degrees, 37 minutes West 2100 feet to point "A"; thence South 63 degrees 23 minutes East 500 feet along the South line of Westchester Estates S/D; thence South 26 degrees, 37 min. West 428.30 feet to the point of beginning;

Thence South 63 degrees, 23 minutes East - 1324.20 feet; thence South 26 degrees, 37 minutes West - 476.98 feet to a proposed road; thence along said road North 63 degrees, 23 minutes West - 1324.20 feet; thence North 26 degrees, 37 minutes East - 476.98 feet to the point of departure.

The above property is subject to a drainage easement granted to the Police Jury of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, and delineated and designated on plat of survey as #W 20. All as shown on plat of survey by J. V. Burkes, C. E. #4690, dated February 12, 1965, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION TWO: THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that all of the above property as described shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana, to be known as Salmen Junior High School.
