

ORDINANCE NO. 749

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City to include the following described land.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive at their regular monthly meeting of December 7th, 1965, a petition signed by Mrs. Jewell M. Cunningham, Mr. Eugene N. Cloninger, Mrs. Mildred B. Ezell, Mr. Harold E. Brumfield and Mr. Gus Baldwin, requesting an enlargement of the present boundaries of the City of Slidell to include the following described property, and:

WHEREAS, said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioners are the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petitions to be held on December 27th, 1965, at the City Hall, as published in the Slidell St. Tammany Times under date of December 16th and 23rd, 1965. That said hearing was held on said date, and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

SECTION ONE: THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen for the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property:

That certain tract of land, lying and being situated in Lot 5 of Section 3, Township 9, South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, fronting 100 feet on East Hall Avenue by a depth of 300 feet, jointly owned by Mrs. Mildred B. Ezell and Harold E. Brumfield.

That certain tract of land, lying and being situated in Lot 5 of Section 3, Township 9, South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, fronting 150 feet on East Hall Avenue by a depth of 300 feet presently owned by Mrs. Jewell M. Cunningham.

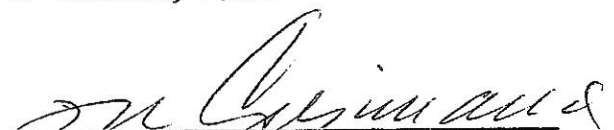
That certain tract of land, lying and being situated in Lot 5 of Section 3, Township 9, South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, fronting 120 feet on Seventh Street by 50 feet in depth, presently owned by Mr. Eugene N. Cloninger.

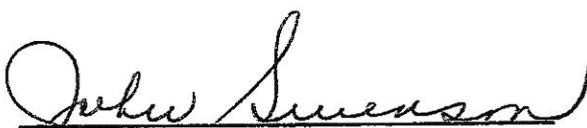
All of Lots 1, 3, 4, and 5, Sq. 2, Log Cabin Subdivision, measuring 400 feet on East Hall (Gause Road) by a depth of 300 feet, presently owned by Mr. Gus B. Baldwin, Jr.

East Hall Avenue (Gause Road) Right of Way from the present Corporation limit at Ridgewood Drive to the East Right of Way line of Interstate 10.

SECTION TWO: NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that all of the above properties as described shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana, immediately upon the passage of this Ordinance.
