

ORDINANCE NO. 753

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City to include, part of Lot 14, all of Lot 15, and part of Lot 16, Square I, Bayou Liberty Gardens.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said Municipality, did receive, at their regular meeting Tuesday, May 3rd, 1966, a petition from Margaret E. Lauer, to include certain property herein described; and

WHEREAS, said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition, to be held May 23rd, 1966, at the City Hall, by publication in the Slidell St. Tammany Times, under the date of May 12th, 1966, and no one gave notice to the City Clerk desiring to be heard with reference to the proposed enlargement.

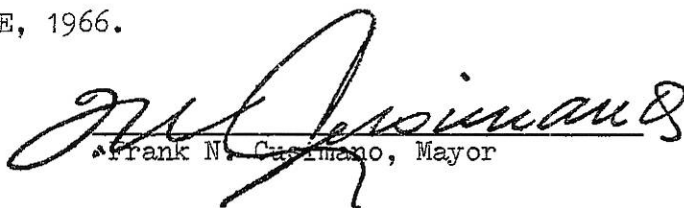
Section 1. THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

"ALL THAT CERTAIN LOT OR PARCEL OF LAND, with all improvements thereon, described as part of Lot 14, all of Lot 15 and part of lot 16 in Square 'I' Bayou Liberty Gardens, lying and being situated in Section 38 T 9 S R 14 E and more fully described as follows:

From the SE corner of lot 16 go north 86 degrees 20 minutes west along the north edge of Liberty Drive a distance of 22.6 feet to the point of beginning. Thence go north 80 degrees 20 minutes west 181.4 feet along the north edge of Liberty Drive; thence go North 7 degrees 50 minutes west a distance of 272.9 feet; thence go north 1 degree 5 minutes east a distance of 139.1 feet to the north line of the subdivision; thence go south 86 degrees 20 minutes east a distance of 224.1 feet along the north line of the subdivision; thence go south 1 degree 5 minutes west a distance of 407.1 feet to the north edge of Liberty Drive, which is the point of beginning." As per survey by Lamar P. Harrison C. E., dated June 22nd, 1955.

Section 2. THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that all of the above property, as described, shall be included and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
