

ORDINANCE NO. 754

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, extending the boundaries of the said City to include a parcel of land 200 feet on East Hall Avenue by a depth of 300 feet.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said Municipality, did receive, at their regular meeting Tuesday, June 7th, 1966, a petition from Maurice C. Mistich, to include certain property herein described:

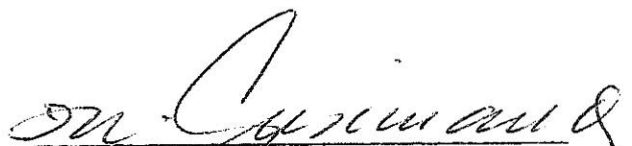
WHEREAS, said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition, to be held June 27th, 1966, and no one gave notice to the City Clerk desiring to be heard with reference to the proposed enlargement.

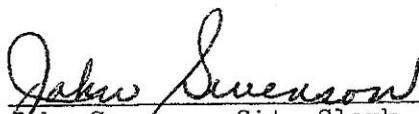
Section 1. THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

That certain tract of land, lying and being situated in Lot 5 of Section 3, Township 9, South Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, fronting 200 feet on East Hall Avenue, by a depth of 300 feet, less a portion 50 feet by 100 feet owned by Eugene N. Cloninger.

Section 2. THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that all of the above property, described, shall be included and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
