

ORDINANCE NO. 756

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City to include 49.81 acres, more or less, on Rama Street.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said Municipality, did receive, at their regular meeting, Tuesday, June 7th, 1966, a petition from the Gulfside Investment Corporation, Michael E. Haas, President, to include certain property herein described:

WHEREAS, said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition, to be held June 27th, 1966, and no one gave notice to the City Clerk desiring to be heard with reference to the proposed enlargement.

SECTION 1. THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

Rama Street from the existing corporate limits to and including the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain tract or portion of land, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in Section 44, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, as shown on a survey by Joseph Pugh, Surveyor, dated July 18, 1930, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

From the Southeast corner of Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, run South 27 degrees 30 minutes West 38.53 chains to the point of beginning.

From the point of beginning run South 44 degrees 45 minutes East 20 chains, thence South 45 degrees West 25 chains thence North 44 degrees 45 minutes West 20 chains, thence North 45 degrees East 25 chains to the point of beginning, containing 50 acres, more or less.

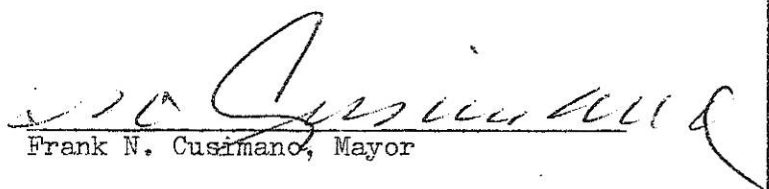
The hereinabove described property has been recently surveyed by James S. Boyd, Surveyor, by his survey dated June 4, 1965, revised June 11, 1965, revised June 29, 1965, and revised September 9, 1965, said property is described as follows, to-wit:

All that certain tract or portion of land, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in Section 44, Township 9 South Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, as shown on a survey by James S. Boyd, dated June 4, 1965, revised June 11, 1965, revised June 29, 1965, and revised September 9, 1965, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

From the point 159 feet South of corner common to Sections 14, 44 and 15, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, and 132 feet West of corner common to Sections 14, 23 and 44, run South 27 degrees 30 minutes West 2546 feet to a point on the Southwest boundary of Beach View Subdivision which is the point of beginning; thence go along the Southwest boundary of the Beach view Subdivision and Spanish Trail Highlands South 44 degrees 45 minutes East 1315 feet; thence go South 45 degrees 0 minutes West 1650 feet; thence go North 44 degrees 45 minutes West 1320 feet; thence go North 45 degrees 10 minutes east 1650 feet to the point of beginning, containing 49.81 acres more or less.

SECTION 2. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that all of the above property, described, shall be included and become part of the City of Slidell.
