

ORDINANCE NO. 761

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City of Slidell to include ten (10) acres of land, and U. S. Highway 190 East.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of September 13th, 1966, a petition from Herbert G. Brown, Robert L. Pettit, Jr., and Clifford Ourso, through Brian R. Patey, to include certain property therein described, and;

WHEREAS, said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioners are the sole owners of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition to be held on October 3rd, 1966, at the City Hall, by publication in the Slidell St. Tammany Times, under dates of September 22nd, 29th, 1966. That said hearing was held on said date, and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

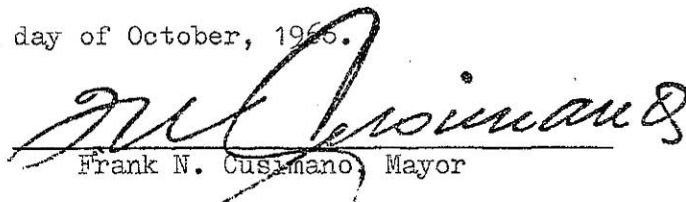
SECTION ONE: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

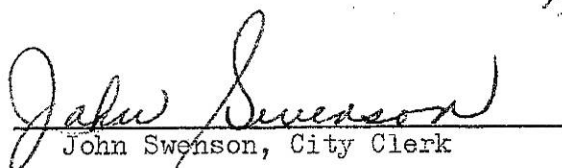
Highway 190 East from the existing corporate limits to and include that certain piece or parcel of ground, together with all buildings and improvements thereon, and all the right of ways, privileges, servitudes, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, as shown on a survey by J. S. Boyd & Associates dated July 25, 1966, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

From the S. E. corner of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T9S, R14E, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, go West 462 feet to the point of beginning; thence go South 245.75 feet to a point; thence North $89^{\circ} 55'$ West 464.29' to a point; thence go North $0^{\circ} 28'$ East 775.05 feet to a point; thence North $54^{\circ} 39'$ East 313.66 feet to the right of way line of U. S. Highway 190; thence South $45^{\circ} 37'$ East along said right of way line 70.71 feet; thence go South $47^{\circ} 05'$ West 148.50'; thence South $44^{\circ} 50'$ East 90'; thence North $40^{\circ} 00'$ East 150 feet to the right of way line of U. S. Highway 190; thence South $45^{\circ} 37'$ East 140' along said right of way line to a point; Thence go South 514.0 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION TWO: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all of the property as above described shall be included in and become a part of the said City of Slidell, Louisiana.
