

ORDINANCE NO. 764

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the City of Slidell to include one-half acre of land, fronting on Carroll Road.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive at their regular meeting of November 8th, 1966, a petition from Willie George Nelson to include certain property therein described, and;

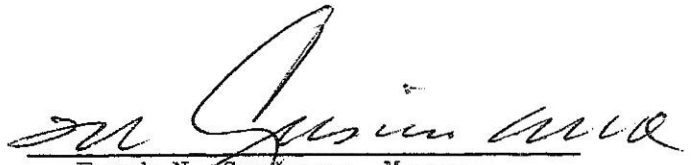
WHEREAS, said governing Body did investigate, and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property, and did give notice of a hearing on said petition to be held on November 18th, 1966, at the City Hall, by publication in the Slidell St. Tammany Times, under dates of November 17th and 24th, 1966. That said hearing was held on said date, and at said hearing no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

SECTION ONE: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the James Autrey's one acre tract, go South 55 feet, West 415.6 feet to a corner on the East side of the Carroll Road, thence go along said road North 27 degrees 30 minutes East 62 feet, thence East 387 feet to the place of beginning, and containing a half acre, and is a part of the fractional Southwest corner of Section 4, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, Greensburg District, Louisiana, as per survey by Joseph Pugh, dated May 29th, 1945, and bearing his number 1258.

SECTION TWO: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all of the property as above described shall be included in and become part of the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
