

ORDINANCE NO. 774

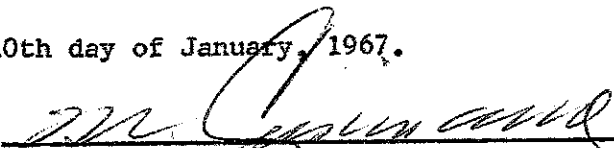
An ordinance revoking and setting aside the dedication of certain streets laid out and dedicated to public use within the corporate limits of City of Slidell, Louisiana, as being no longer needed for public purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

Section 1. The following streets, laid out and dedicated to public use within the corporate limits of City of Slidell, Louisiana, are no longer needed for public purposes, and the dedication of such streets is hereby revoked and set aside, to-wit:

- a. Fairbanks Street, from the East right-of-way line of Fifth Street to the West right-of-way line of Sixth Street.
- b. Dewey Avenue, from the East right-of-way line of Fifth Street to the West right-of-way line of Eighth Street.
- c. Brakefield Street, from the East right-of-way line of Fifth Street to the West right-of-way line of Sixth Street.
- d. Sixth Street, from the North right-of-way line of Brakefield Street to the South right-of-way line of Fairbanks Street.
- ☒ e. Seventh Street, from the North right-of-way line of Brakefield Street to a point one hundred twenty (120) feet North of the North right-of-way line of Dewey Avenue.
